Recall key events.

Who was the main character?

How did he feel?

What do you predict will happen next?

Justify your opinions with evidence from the text.

Discuss any new vocabulary with your child and encourage them to share new words with their class.

Log on to TTRS and practise the times tables set for you at least 3 times a week for 10 minutes.

Individual times tables have been set. Log in and go to 'Garage' to practise these.
