Counting back through 0. Adding and subtracting from a negative number. Look at negative numbers in real life contexts such as money and temperature.
<p>Arts- Music/Art/DT</p> <p>In music we will learn how to read music by focusing on how to read and perform rhythmic patterns. We will see how the ancient Greek mathematicians influenced the music notation we use today.
