## **Westbay trip- Checklist:**

- <u>Suitable Clothing:</u> Children do not need to wear school uniform. Clothing should be suitable and appropriate for the potential conditions in June. We recommend having light long sleeves and bottoms to avoid sunburn.
- <u>Comfortable and suitable footwear</u>. The trip will involve a lot of walking across fields and on the beach. Please wear comfortable footwear than you do not mind getting dirty.
- **Suitable rucksack to carry equipment**. Please avoid handbags or plastic shopping bags. A rucksack carried over the shoulders will be best.
- Water bottle.
- Sun hat
- **Sun cream**. Please apply a layer before coming to school and ensure your child is able to apply more as they require on the trip.
- Snack. Children will not be in school for break time so they will need an
  easy to carry snack. As the walk will be quite long for some children please
  ensure they have enough food (slightly more than a usual break-time
  snack).
- <u>Light, summer rain coat</u>. Rain is always a possibility and once we are on the walk we will have very little cover or shelter.
- Spare clothes in school. We suggest that children bring spare shoes and socks, and perhaps even trousers and top. Even a little bit of rain and damp could cause a lot of discomfort so it would be beneficial to have spare, warm clothes to change in to when we return to school.
