

















# St. Mary's Behaviour Charter

<p><b>Ready</b></p> 	<p>Wear school uniform with pride</p> <p>Bring in our book bag and our PE kits.</p> <p>Be ready to listen actively to all</p> <p>Put lunch boxes on trolley</p> <p>Coats and PE kits on peg</p>	<p>Agree support that helps you learn and have specific resources with you when needed</p> <p>Be ready with pencil, pen etc.</p> <p>In KS2, your reading book should be on your desk.</p> <p>Accept mistakes help your brain to grow- be ready to correct and edit</p> <p>No way through isn't true</p>	<p>Remember lunch time jobs/ clubs and be where you are expected to be</p> <p>Wear a coat when needed</p> <p>Play in the right areas</p> <p>Place equipment away when asked.</p>	<p> Sit sensibly with someone you can enjoy lunch with</p> <p>Have your bottle and lunch box with you </p> <p>Sit sensibly next to someone you can listen with</p> <p>Walk in and wait or sing</p> <p>Be ready for moment of stillness and calmness</p>	<p>Visit bathrooms at the right time</p> <p>Only 1 in the cubicle at a time</p> <p>Wash your hands before you eat.</p>
<p><b>Respect -ful</b></p> 	<p>Listen and follow instructions from any adult</p> <p>Be helpful where you can</p> <p>Share whenever you can</p> <p>Celebrate successes</p> <p>Listen and speak politely to all</p> <p>Treat others fairly -too much selfie isn't healthy!</p> <p>Celebrate diversity</p>	<p>Talk and listen with kindness to teachers, TAs, volunteers, visitors and each other</p> <p>Value, encourage and praise other children</p> <p>Be Tidy-respect equipment and resources</p> <p>Respect everyone's uniqueness and individuality</p> <p>Be aware of your noise level- too much noise makes it hard to learn</p>	<p>Talk and listen to all lunch staff, teachers and TAs with respect</p> <p>Be kind and tolerant of everyone on the playground</p> <p>Treat your friends with respect- banter and jokes can be hurtful</p> <p>Upstand respectfully if you need to</p> <p>Respect nature</p>	<p> Listen to the adults and follow their requests</p> <p>Talk quietly in the hall -it can be loud.</p> <p>Show kindness and respect to each other-don't forget to let love in!</p> <p> Respect moments of silence and discussion</p> <p>Listen to others and join in</p>	<p>Keep the bathroom area tidy</p> <p>Take turns using the cubicle</p> <p>Value privacy</p> <p>Take only yourself to the toilets</p> <p>Use one or two paper towels, scrunch up small and put into bin</p>
<p><b>Safe</b></p> 	<p>Use equipment safely</p> <p>Walk when moving around the school and thorough the courtyard</p> <p>Keep feet on the ground unless on a climbing frame or during PE</p> <p>Talk to a trusted adult if you feel unsafe</p>	<p>Use all equipment in the safest way</p> <p>Follow the routines for entering and exiting the classroom</p> <p>Tuck in your chairs</p> <p>Keep the classroom tidy and clutter free</p> <p>Throwing is for outside and for PE lessons</p>	<p>Use the equipment in the way you have been shown.</p> <p>Follow the rules around specific areas- monkey bars/treehouse/woodland</p> <p>Sticks should be used safely- elbow to wrist size</p> <p>Be safe in the seasons-use ice, leaves, puddles and grass cuttings safely</p>	<p> Walk to the hall and around the hall</p> <p>If you do not want an item of food, please put into the bin.</p> <p> Sit, listen and reflect safely</p>	<p>Let an adult know if something is wrong or needs replacing</p> <p>Be aware of wet floors</p> <p>Walk</p> <p>Use the taps to wash your hands and then go back to class.</p>
